PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Instruments & Youth Scholarship/Sponsorship Program

MAMA believes that every child deserves the opportunity to express themselves through music, and to pursue their musical passions. **Through donating instruments and music gear to music education programs and individuals in need**, MAMA is helping to **provide fundamental tools necessary for musical creativity and expression** – which is essential to healthy brain development.

To date MAMA has donated hundreds of instruments and gear to youth musicians and local music programs, helping to strengthen the ecosystem of music education and ensure that young musicians have access to the tools they need for musical success. **MAMA also provides financial support to youth musicians in need** – through sponsorship for summer music camps and clinics, and through the MAMA Scholarship Fund in Honor of Clyde Stubblefield for those on a collegiate music path. **To date MAMA has awarded \$9,920** in scholarships to young folks on their musical journeys.

MAMA Cares

Many that work within MAMA are working musicians, so we understand the unique challenges faced by them. The MAMA Cares fund was created to provide emergency financial assistance to musicians facing loss of income due to medical bills, equipment theft, or other circumstances. Since its inception, MAMA Cares has provided \$112,044 in aid to musicians in need, helping them to focus on recovery without the added burden of financial stress. The 2025 MAMA Cares 10 Year Anniversary Ball had hundreds in attendance, and raised \$9,775 toward the MC fund.

The Annual MAMA Awards

For over 20 years, “the MAMAs” has been a staple in the Madison music community. Held annually, the awards show honors and showcases the incredible talent within our music community. MAMA gives out over 80 individual awards to outstanding local musicians, composers, educators, and industry professionals – giving gratitude to the Madison music community while inspiring future generations of artists. The ceremony as a whole not only gives well-deserved recognition and a vibrant platform for community connection, but also raises significant funds toward MAMA's mission. The 2025 ceremony had over 200 in attendance, and raised \$4,400.

COMMUNITY IMPACT

The impact of MAMA's work reverberates throughout our city. By investing in youth music education and supporting our established artists, we are helping to cultivate a robust and celebrated music community that can thrive year after year. MAMA's work within the city ensures that musical talent is nurtured in young hearts, while experienced and established musicians are sustained and celebrated.

This cyclical support system is key to achieving MAMA's overall vision of a self-regenerating community of musical excellence – where a passion for music is ignited, celebrated, and passed down through generations.
